


School Announces Poster Making Competition for Earth Day

This event aimed to inspire students to express their creativity and raise awareness about environmental issues through art. Students got the opportunity to showcase their talent and share their vision for a healthier planet.







SOCIAL SCIENCE ACTIVITY CLASS 10TH





Think, Pair and Share activity conducted on the Topic 'Power Sharing'

Think, pair and share activity was presented by class 10th students. Students from all the sections participated in it enthusiastically, where they explained Power sharing. It means the distribution of power among the organs of the government such as the legislature, executive and judiciary. Power sharing helps in achieving the stability of political order. In power-sharing, power might even be shared at distinct levels such as union, state and local. The Different Forms of Power sharing in Modern Democracies are Horizontal Distribution of Power, Community Government, Power-sharing Between Political Parties and Vertical Distribution of Power.



Students explained the examples of two countries with great zeal about the Ethnic Composition of Belgium . 59% Dutch living in the Flemish region, 40% French living in the Wallonia region and the rest 1% Germans . And in Srilanka the major social groups are the Sinhala – speakers (74 %) and the Tamil– speakers (18 %). Among Tamils there are two subgroups. Tamil natives of the country are called Sri Lankan Tamils (13%). The rest are called Indian Tamils.



The CUET was introduced in the country for the first time in 2022. It provides a single window opportunity to students seeking admission in any of the Central Universities (CUs) or other participating organizations State Universities, Deemed and Private Universities across the country.
