# THE POWER OF ARGUMENTS AND THE ART OF DIALOGUE










R.M. Public School Successfully Conducts Plantation Drive





# **WORK OF IMAGINATION**



which was conducted on August 12, 2024.


The aim behind conducting the activity was to instill a sense of pride and patriotism among students.


# **CARDS CRAFTED WITH PATRIOTISM**

#### **FREEDOM FEST**










# **EXTEMPORE COMPETITION**











Extempore is one such method which assists the students not only in thinking on their own, but also invoicing their creative ideas with precision.
