A mission that explores, the secrets of the sky.

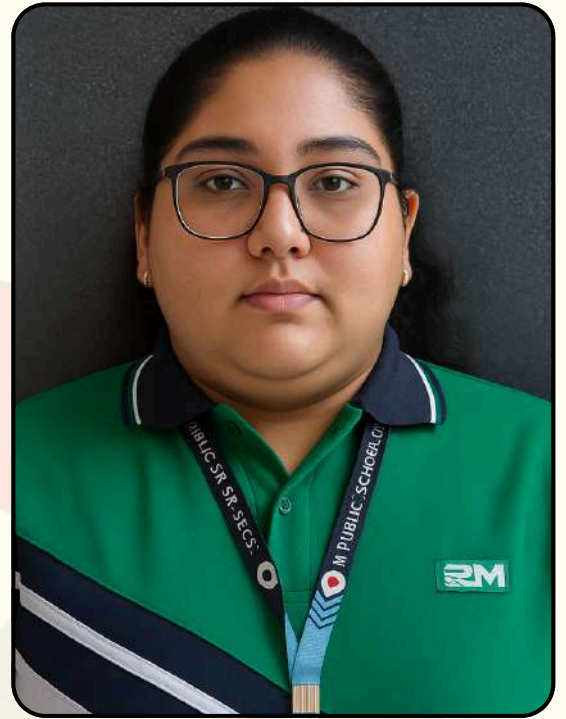
Chandrayaan 3, a journey so grand,

Little Learners Make a Splash at “Rain Dance & Pool Party” – A Day of Joy, Water, and Wonder!

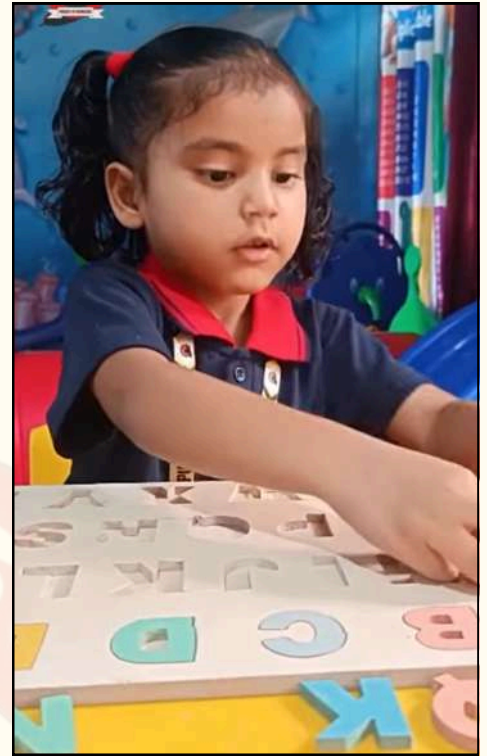
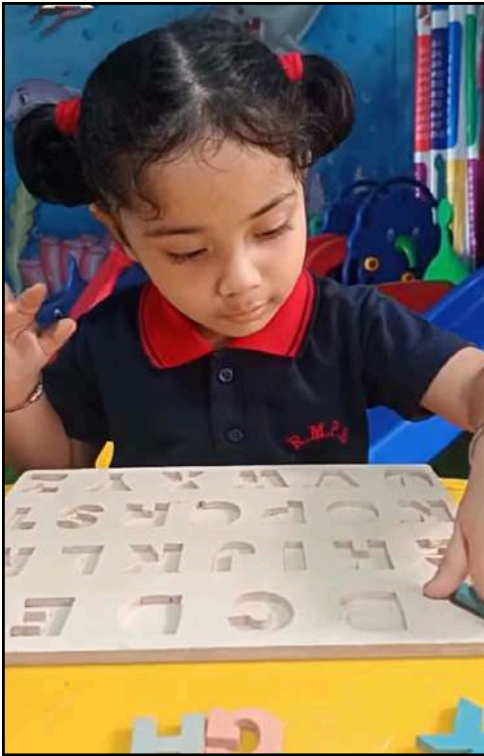

Penguin Paradise Hosts “Bagless Day - Fireless Cooking Activity”

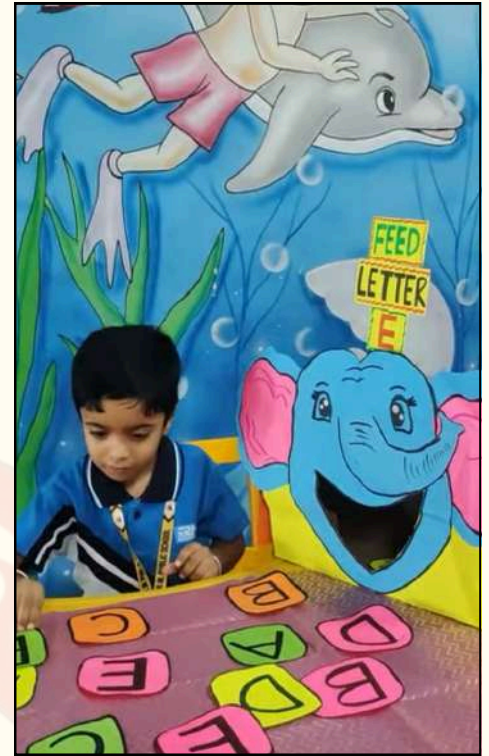
